

ADDENDUM 2: January 27, 2015
Distributed Generation RFP Supplemental Questions

1) Does SCPPA wish to consider any non-generation technologies (e.g., demand response) in this study?

The primary focus and intent is on distributed generation technologies. However, if Respondents want to and can propose cost-effective automated demand response opportunities that the Utility can control, then yes - such options would be considered as an additional benefit to a proposal. Such consideration may or may not impact the results of the DG RFP Response review and evaluation but instead could be reserved for separate and distinct consideration at a later time.

2) Are SCPPA members expecting that the DG opportunities will generate electricity for on-site consumption or that they will be net-metered and transmit electricity to the grid?

There is an expectation that the successful Respondent(s) may find cost-effective opportunities for DG systems to provide partial capacity and energy requirements for on-site use at certain locations while also finding opportunities to install DG systems that could exceed on-site requirements and that feed excess production into the grid.
